If the statutory conditions are met, you have the following rights under Articles 15 to 20 of the GDPR: right of access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing and data portability. Article 22 GDPR gives you the right not to be subject to solely automated decision-making.

Under Article 77 GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Baden-Württemberg Regional Data Protection Officer, if you believe that your personal data are not being processed lawfully.

Your data is handled in a strictly confidential manner, and there is no transfer to third parties except in the cases listed above. You have the right to request information about your stored personal data. At **any time** you have the right to change or totally **revoke** the given **consent** to your registration as an applicant and to data storage without giving reasons. Your personal data will then be deleted from the data processing systems of the DKFZ and of the involved institutions. There will be no further disadvantages for you.
